

[Philemon:] 3/17/2017: Brian MacFarlane:

① Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ, and Timothy our brother, unto Philemon our dearly beloved, and fellowlabourer, ② And to our beloved Apphia, and Archippus our fellowsoldier, and to the church in thy house: ③ Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ④ I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers, ⑤ Hearing of thy love and faith, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all saints; ⑥ That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you Christ Jesus. ⑦ For we have great joy and consolation in thy love, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by thee, brother. ⑧ Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin thee that which is convenient, ⑨ Yet for love's sake I rather beseech thee, being such as an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ. ⑩ I beseech thee for my son Onesimus, whom I have begotten in my bonds: ⑪ Which in time past was to thee unprofitable, but now profitable to thee and to me: ⑫ Whom I have sent again: thou therefore receive him, that is, mine own bowels: ⑬ Whom I would ~~have~~ retained with me, that in thy stead he might have ministered unto me in the bonds of the gospel: ⑭ But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly. ⑮ For perhaps he therefore departed for a season, that thou shouldest receive him for ever; ⑯ Not now as a servant, but above a servant, a brother beloved,

specially to me, but how much more unto thee, both in the  
flesh and in the Lord? (7) If thou count me therefore a  
partner, receive him as my self. (8) If he hath wronged thee,  
or oweth thee ought, put that on mine account; (9) I Paul  
have written it with mine own hand, I will repay it ~~albeit~~  
I do not say to thee how thou owest unto me even thine own  
self besides. (10) Yea, brother, let me have joy of thee in the  
Lord: refresh my bowels in the Lord. (11) Having confidence  
in thy obedience I wrote unto thee, knowing that thou wilt  
also do more than I say. (12) But ~~without~~ prepare me  
also a lodging: for I trust that through your prayers I  
shall be given unto you. (13) There salute thee Ephaphras,  
my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus; (14) Marcus, Aristarchus,  
~~Demas~~, Lucas my ~~fellow prisoner~~ fellow labourers. (15) The  
grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.
